Your Identification Documents

Accepted Primary Photo Identification Documents

- Passport

OR

OPTION 2 – Non-Photo Identification

If you cannot provide a primary photo identification document then you must provide one primary non-photo document AND one secondary document.

Primary Non-Photo Identification Document

- Birth Certificate
- Citizenship Certificate
- Pension Card

PLUS ONE OF THE FOLLOWING

Secondary Non-Photo Identification Document

- Marriage Certificate
- Utilities Notice
- Council Rates Notice
- Bank or Credit Card Statement

List of Authorised Certifiers

The following people are able to certify your identification documents.

1. A Justice of the Peace
2. An accountant who is a member of either Chartered Accountants Australia & New Zealand, CPA Australia or Institute of Public Accountants, with two or more years of continuous membership
3. A police officer
4. An agent of Australia Post who is in charge of an office supplying postal services to the public
5. A permanent employee of Australia Post with two or more years continuous service who is employed in an office supplying postal services to the public
6. A legal practitioner
7. A judge
8. A magistrate
9. A Chief Executive Officer of a Federal Court
10. A Registrar or Deputy Registrar of a court
11. An Australian Consular or Diplomatic Officer
12. An officer with, or authorised representative of, a holder of an Australian Financial Service Licence, having two or more continuous years of service with one or more licensees
13. A finance company officer with two or more continuous years of service with one or more finance companies
14. An officer with two or more continuous years of service with one or more financial institutions

Notice to Investors / Authorised Signatories

Privacy Notice: The Privacy Act allows UC Invest to disclose personal information about you when related to the primary purpose of providing our products and services to you and managing our business. Personal information may include details to identify you and verify your identity, such as your name, date of birth and current address. If you do not provide us with the personal information that we request, we may not be able to consider your application or provide other services.

In some circumstances, we will need to provide your details to another organisation within Australia. Anti-Money Laundering and Counter Terrorism Financing (AML/CTF) Act 2006: By signing this application form you are providing your express consent to collect personal information from you as required by the AML/CTF Act and that UC Invest may take steps to verify the personal information it has collected. Where UC Invest utilises on-line verification, it will only use the assessment provided by the Reporting Body for the purpose of verifying your identity in accordance with the AML/CTF Act.
